You may be satiated with partridges or pheasants--even with grouse in August and September--but the woodcocks come in capricious flights, and, when there is open weather in the far north, may provokingly defer their arrival. They are essentially birds of passage, and though many breed in the West of Ireland, in the combes of our southern counties, and in the great pine-woods of the Scottish Highlands, they cannot now be said to have naturalised themselves with us. It must have been very different in the olden time, when England was forest land from Tyne to Trent, when the Eastern shires were overgrown with reed...
