W. Bristow, and was included in Sheet 9 of the Geological Survey Map of England, published in the year 1864. In this original mapping the superficial deposits were not represented. During the general revision of the Geological Survey of the South of England, the district here described has been re-examined by Mr. Clement Reid, who in 1885 mapped it on the scale of six inches to one mile, and traced the distribution of all its superficial deposits. Two editions of the Map are issued, one showing the areas occupied by the Cretaceous and Eocene strata (Solid Geology edition), the other displaying the distribution of the various surface-deposits by which nearly the whole district is covered (Drift edition). The present Explanation has been prepared by Mr. Reid. It is intended only as a general guide to the use of the Map,...
